## **MINUTES**

## **Funding Requests**

Allen Bolick, representing the BE Educational, Arts & Cultural Complex came before the board with a request of \$25,650 to help with repairs to the HBES. There are 3 areas of concern that Mr. Bolick would like to see repaired. These repairs include replacement of doors at the back of the building, electric repairs to rooms 4 &5, 17 & 18 and replacement of the sidewalk between the building & Mayland Community College classrooms. The timeline is flexible and could be broken into different grants. Tom McMurray made a motion to grant \$12.000 now of the 1/3 portion of the budget and pay the remaining \$13,650 after the first of the year out of the 1/3 portion as well when the project is ready to go (sidewalk). Shannon Maness seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous, and the motion passed.

## **New Business**

Craig Distl, from Distl PR, updated the board on Google Analytics from our website. The bounce rate is still good, and the sessions are up. Website traffic continues to be strong up over 26%. He and Nancy are working on the fall marketing campaign.

With no further business, Tom McMurray made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Shannon Maness seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.
